RS MP Parimal Nathwani's One More Gift to Ranchi

A Marriage Hall to be built at Sun Temple from the MP's Fund

Ranchi, January 17, 2018: Member of Parliament in Rajya Sabha from Jharkhand Shri Parimal Nathwani has decided to take yet another noble initiative for the State of Jharkhand. Shri Nathwani has decided to allocate fund from his MP LAD for construction of a Marriage Hall at the famous Sun Temple in Ranchi.

The total area of construction will be around 7,000 square feet. The new marriage hall will have facilities such as modern kitchen, dining area, rooms for bride & groom, proper sanitation arrangements, etc. "The decision to construct a marriage hall has been taken considering the need and representation of the local community in the area. I hope the new marriage hall will help the community celebrate marriage of their sons and daughters, one of the most important events of their life, in most comfortable way," said Shri Parimal Nathwani, Member of Rajya Sabha.

Moreover, the approach of the Sun Temple will also be illuminated with lights. The construction cost of the marriage hall and illumination of the approach road will be known only after the scope of work is finalized. "We will start work on the pre-construction activities soon," said Shri Nathwani.

Shri Nathwani visited the Sun Temple on Tuesday. Ex-MP of Rajya Sabha from Jharkhand Shri Ajay Maroo along with other prominent leaders, who are also associated with the temple Shri Pramod ji, Shri Kanta Prasad Singh, Shri Vinay Kumar Gupta and Shri Vivek Anand Jaiswal also remained present during the MP's visit.

The Sun Temple built is built by Sanskriti Vihar headed by Shri Sita Ram Maroo, the Managing Director of Ranchi Express Group. It is designed in the form of a gigantic chariot with 18 richly decorated wheels (9 on each side) driven by 7 life-like white horses. The temple in a calm and peaceful environment has a pond in its complex, which serves as a sacred place for Chhathavratris (devotees taking part in the Chhath Pooja, ie Festival of the Sun God) for worshipping the Sun. It is believed that by taking a dip in this sacred pond the devotees will get relief from all sins.
